Plant critical operational risks are effectively managed using various safety risk assessment tools such as HAZOP, QRA, HAC, and LPS. Over the years 2022-23, a significant number of recommendations were implemented to mitigate these risks successfully.

Additional measures have been initiated to further enhance the management of operational risks and reach the highest level of safety. These include the implementation of Barrier Health Management (BHM) studies, layer of protection analysis (LOPA), and safety integrity level (SIL) studies, which began in 2022 and continue to be an ongoing focus.

By incorporating these advanced risk assessment methodologies and safety measures, the plant aims to fortify its safety barriers and ensure the utmost protection against potential hazards, solidifying its commitment to maintaining a secure operational environment.
