

Chemplast sign on Rasool, Bawne

Chennai: Parvez Rasool and Ankit Bawne were signed on by Chemplast on Tuesday for the upcoming Tamil Nadu Cricket Association (TNCA) League which starts on July 4.



Confirming the news, Bharat Reddy of Chemplast, said, "We officially have Rasool and Maharashtra batsman Bawne on board. We were in talks with them, and the

deal was finalised only on Tuesday. The deal with Rasool took time because the courier that was sent to his place in Srinagar reached on Tuesday morning, and he duly completed the formalities," said Reddy while speaking to TOI.

Chemplast also has Manan Vohra and Sheldon Jackson in their ranks. While Jackson will be playing for Jolly Rovers, Chemplast is still to decide which club the other three will play for.

Therefore, the names of Rasool, Vohra and Bawne are yet to be submitted to TNCA. "The rule

book states that when you submit a name to the TNCA, the form must contain as to which club the player will play. We have two teams in the league (Jolly Rovers and Alwarpet CC) and are yet to zero down on which of the two teams the three will feature. Also, Vohra and Rasool are part of India A's tour of Australia, so we are yet to submit their names to TNCA. Also, according to the rules of TNCA, an outstation cricketer can be registered 72 hours before a match at any stage of the tournament," mentioned Reddy.
